Looking to plant food plots on your preserve? Come see our UF/IFAS cool season forage demonstration plots



Join UF/IFAS Extension in Marion County for a coolseason forage field day on February 13th, 2020. This program will take place on a beautiful cattle ranch and preserve in Marion County. The field day will include instructional lectures from UF/IFAS Marion County Extension Livestock Agent, Caitlin Bainum as well as the UF/IFAS CHeRI (Cervidae Health Research Initiative) team. The afternoon will consist of a tour of this year's cool-season forage demonstration plots. We will go to the field and discuss 24 forage varieties and forage blends planted for their application in beef cattle operations, horse farms, and wildlife food plots. Topics covered include but are not limited to; forage selection, planting, fertilization, and deer farm management.





The CHeRI Diagnostic Lab processed samples from 137 farmed deer this year. The necropsy team traveled to farms and conducted 109 field necropsies. The rest of the samples either came from ship-in's or were taken from live deer. We saw our first case of EHDV this year in June and the cases did not stop until the end of November.
